Monthly Water Increase

Just a reminder -Please be aware that our water and sewer rates will be increasing again beginning in January. The increase will be reflected in your February statement. Please see the Town of Manila's website manilautah.com for these changes. If you have any questions, you may contact our office.

Public Utility Charges

The office continually receives calls on why non-residents are required to pay for water, sewer, and garbage when they aren't here except for during the summer months. Please find below the Municipal Code:

Title 13, Public Utilities and Services, Chapter 13.05 Water and Sewer System 13.05.610 Water and sewer users responsible to pay monthly rates when.

A. Consistent with the established practice and requirements of Manila and that of other municipal water and sewer systems in Utah, all users of the water, sewer, and curbside trash pickup services must pay the established current rate, inclusive of any water overages incurred, charged each and every month of the calendar year.

B. The above-stated obligation to each of the water, sewer, and curbside trash pickup customers to pay the current monthly fee promptly each and every month of the year shall not be affected by use or occupancy. Absence from a residence, vacancy of a trailer or dwelling, or closure of a business shall not relieve the user from the monthly fee obligation.
