USDA RURAL DEVELOPMENT GRANT/LOAN

The Town of Manila has applied for a grant or grant/loan combination to provide program funding for sanitary sewage disposal, sanitary solid waste disposal, and stormwater drainage to households and businesses in eligible rural areas. Currently, Gunnison, Hildale, and Cedar City operate this product with great success. This is the one that has been recommended to Manila by the Rural Water of Utah Association. This would be a great compliment to our new lagoon which is being paid for through a CIB grant. LANDFILL UPDATE!!

Effective **September 2, 2024**, the town residential garbage started pick-up on **Tuesdays**. We asked that you have your garbage out, bagged, and in cans or enclosed containers by 7:00 am. Beginning in November, we will start our winter hours so be sure to complete the multitude of your yard clean-up before November 1st!

Winter Landfill Hours:

Winter hours for the landfill start **November 1st, 2024**. The landfill will be open Monday from 8:00 am-12:00 pm. and the first Saturday of the month from 8:00 am-2:00 pm.



Garbage Pickup

Please remember that a resident is only allowed **FIVE** garbage bags no larger than 35 gallons. They must be in a covered garbage can and set alongside the street. If you put the 45- or 54-gallon contractor bags out for pickup, they will be left for you to take them to the landfill. Also, Public Works will not pick up garbage bags tied to a fence or post.

ALL GARBAGE MUST BE IN A CAN!

Overage

Over five 35-gallon garbage bags up to 10 bags will be \$2.00 each and additional bags over 11 bags will be \$5.00 each.

Contact for Sewer/Water

Any action that needs to be taken for the town Public Works should be called into the Town Office to be placed on a work order. **After-hours emergency contacts for Public Works at (435)778-0038.** For non-emergency after-hours callouts, the homeowner will be charged a \$50.00 call-out charge.

Housing Identifiers and Blue Stakes

If Blue Stakes (8-1-1 "Call Before You Dig") are marking for water, sewer, power, or fiber optic and the house number is not visible, the location will not be serviced until the house is identified. When calling Public Works or the office to service your water or sewer, we cannot respond to your service request if there are no house numbers on your property.

Home Energy Assistance Target (HEAT) Program

Do you need help paying your home energy bills? The HEAT program provides energy assistance to low-income households throughout the state of Utah. Assistance is on a one-time basis and is subject to a qualifying process. **The Vernal HEAT Office will be in Manila on Thursday, Oct. 3 at 9:30 a.m. at the Community/Senior Center. Please call to schedule an appointment with the Vernal HEAT Office at 435-781-2021.** Assistance will be available while filling out the application.
